In celebration of the rising of the star cluster Matariki, the Insight service is hosting a bring-and-share meal in the Chartwell Church hall on **Sunday August 2nd from 5.30-7.30pm** to which you are all warmly invited.



Matariki heralds the start of a new year for Maori. The season has rich themes to it including remembering those who have died, celebrating the earth's produce and sharing our abundance with others.

As well as bringing food for the shared meal, you are also invited to bring along some food (eg tinned or packaged food, fruit or vegetables) which will then be placed in the Paataka Kai outside the church on Bellmont Ave. We also invite you to bring a photo of someone in your family who has died (it can be from generations ago, or someone much more recently).
