### Waste audit at Chartwell Church with Para Kore (part of Eco Church journey)

Sunday the 5th of March, 10.45am onwards.

This wānanga with Para Kore involves tipping out a rubbish sample onto a tarpaulin and sorting the contents into 17 categories. It investigates how much recyclable, compostable, even reusable waste is present in the rubbish sample. Discussions are generated about how to improve current systems, how to reduce waste, what alternatives there are to single use, and how to design the waste out. Waste checks are done annually, so results can be compared, change can be measured, progress and improvements can be celebrated. An annual Waste Check is part of the commitment and agreement in joining Para Kore.

# Lenten Study 2023 - Chartwell Church Feb. 27 to March 28, 2023

# 7:00 - 8:30pm in the Worship Centre

For this year's Lenten Studies, we will explore **the Difference course** - a 5 session course that will help us to see transformation through everyday encounters.

This course was developed in response to the Archbishop of Canterbury Justin Welby's vision of seeing the church as a presence in reconciling conflict in the communities we are a part of. He says, "Reconciliation is not the ending of all difference, but the transformation of how we deal with difference". For more details, https://difference.rln.global/



Feb 27: **God's Call**: God can transform relationships in a conflicted world. God's call and equipping make that possible.

March 6: **Crossing Divides**: God invites us to see where difference or prejudice divide us from others and offers us opportunities to see them as God does.

March 13: **Navigating Disagreement**: God is with us as we face the challenge of disagreement, which can become an opportunity for stronger relationships if handled well.

March 20: **Practising Forgiveness:** God is with us in the mess and complexity of trying to put forgiveness into practice in our relationships.

March 27: **Risking Hope**: Doing relationships God's way will sometimes be risky and resisted, but the hope it brings is transformative.
