For this year's Lenten Studies, we will explore **the Difference course** - a 5 session course that will help us to see transformation through everyday encounters.

This course was developed in response to the Archbishop of Canterbury Justin Welby's vision of seeing the church as a presence in reconciling conflict in the communities we are a part of. March 13: **Navigating Disagreement**: God is with us as we face the challenge of disagreement, which can become an opportunity for stronger relationships if handled well.

March 20: **Practising Forgiveness:** God is with us in the mess and complexity of trying to put forgiveness into practice in our relationships.

March 27: **Risking Hope**: Doing relationships God's way will sometimes be risky and resisted, but the hope it brings is transformative.
