Tip of the week: Did you know that the increased intensity of storm events (rain) that we are seeing currently is a product of climate change? As the earth warms, more evaporation occurs from the oceans. A warmer atmosphere can also store more water temporarily, before releasing it as rain. This leads to more intense storms.
