



Tip of the week: Some good news! The recent "State of the Environment" report by WRC confirmed that Lake Taupo water quality is on the mend. Nitrogen and floating algae (phytoplankton) levels are decreasing and water clarity is increasing! Water quality is the best it has been in 20 years, and deterioration trends, observed a decade ago, have been reversed. This improvement is the result of hard work by regional council, scientists, and the farming community in the catchment! More importantly, it is the product of decisive environmental regulation.
