Eco Corner

Did you know that Lake Rotoroa (Hamilton Lake) used to be a popular swimming spot? Many of you probably do remember that! Unfortunately, the lake was closed for swimming in the mid to late 1980's, primarily due to water quality concerns. The good news is that water quality has improved since then, and work is under way to further improve to return the lake to a swimmable and healthier state. The main water quality issues at the moment are: elevated nutrient and floating algae levels and pathogen bacteria. Nutrients enter the lake primarily via stormwater, originating from things like detergent and fertilizer use and pet waste. The ducks and geese are the primary culprits for the high pathogen bacteria (E. coli) levels! The City is currently working with regional council and community groups to explore ways to reduce contaminant levels in the lake.



Here are a few ways you can help: don't feed the ducks at the lake, don't use phosphorus-based detergents to clean your car, pick up after your dog, and support the City's initiative to clean the lake! Imagine a healthy freshwater swimming spot in the centre of our City!
