

Eco Corner

Did you know...

Polar fleece came on the market in the early 1980s and quickly became a favourite fabric for outerwear because of its lightness and warmth. It is a synthetic fabric often made of recycled plastic so it is frequently hailed as an eco-friendly alternative to other materials.

Unfortunately however it has been found that fleece garments shed microplastic particles when they are washed that end up in our wastewater and on into the food chain. (Microplastics and microfibres are incredibly small bits of plastic waste which have been found everywhere in the environment, including inside humans.)

The solution? Don't throw out all your fleece jackets and hats, but follow the manufacturer's instructions when laundering, usually at low temperatures, and allow to air-dry where practical.
