Countdown stores [soon to be Woolworths!] provide **Soft Plastic Recycling Bins.**

You can put in it — bread bags, produce and frozen food bags, courier packs and bubble wrap, soft plastic packaging e.g. from toilet paper, breakfast cereals and snack foods, lightly foiled bags, chip packets, garden potting mix bags, dry pet food bags.

[Turn your soft plastic into fence posts or planter boxes]

Do not put – compostable plastic bags, face masks, disposable gloves, RAT test packaging, general rubbish, food or drink containers, foil or metal, yoghurt pots and other rigid plastics, heavy foiled bags, cellophane, or anything contaminated with food or liquid.

[Scrunch your plastic into a small ball and we can recycle it]
