## Can you help Holiday Club?


The Chartwell Church Holiday Club is on September 25-27

## <u>Eco Corner</u>

Tip of the week: Three cheers for the return of the Tui to Kirikiriroa Hamilton! According to Andrew Thomas, Biodiversity Officer at Waikato Regional Council (pers. comm.), "Tui were a rare sight in 2007, being seen only in the winter when birds were moving from their breeding grounds into the city for food. Now we see a 15-fold increase in numbers, and they regularly breed within the city limits." This achievement is the result of agency and community restoration and pest control initiatives. According to Andrew, rat control in the City is likely the main driver for this success story. But more protection is needed, and it is up to us! To this end, the Eco Church team is organising a home pest control workshop for the church members so that we can all do our bit! Stay tuned!
