Climate Action Tips:

- **Use Public Transport where possible**
Fact - Community Services Card Holders, Total Mobility users, and people under the age of 25 are eligible for public transport discounts
- **Consolidate your driving and errands**
Try to set aside time to get everything you need to get done at one time to avoid driving back and forth. You could also park in a central location and walk between the locations you need to get to.
- **Carpool**
If others are going where you're going, share the car, and enjoy the company!
- **Compost**
Fact - When organic material ends up in landfill it creates leachate which emits dangerous greenhouse gases - a huge contributor to climate change.
In Hamilton you can use the green food scraps bin provided by the council.
- **Sign petitions about climate action**
