Climate Action Tips:

Use Public Transport where possible
 Fact - Community Services Card Holders,
 Total Mobility users, and people under the age of 25 are eligible for public transport discounts

• Consolidate your driving and errands

Try to set aside time to get everything you need to get done at one time to avoid driving back and forth. You could also park in a central location and walk between the locations you need to get to.

• Carpool

If others are going where you're going, share the car, and enjoy the company!

Compost

Fact - When organic material ends up in landfill it creates leachate which emits dangerous greenhouse gases - a huge contributor to climate change.

In Hamilton you can use the green food scraps bin provided by the council.
