**He Pitopito Kōrero mō te Wairākau  
(A compost Snippet)**

If you're new to composting, thinking about it, or already have a compost set up. Here are some key reasons why we should make the change or keep it up.

Our food scraps and out garden waste are koha from our atua. Compost enriches your soil. It brings life to it and it enhances life within it. It improves your soils ability to grow food.

In a time when we are taking, taking, taking from our natural world, from our atua, composting is one way we GIVE back.

Composting is a reciprocal, regenerative action. It is an example of a circular economy where-by whatever we like to use, we give back to the system to keep things going over and over again.
