Nature in the City news

2023 was another big year for Nature in the City. Our Community Restoration Advisors were lucky to have the assistance of more than 4,500 volunteers, who clocked up an astounding 11,258 hours of restoration work, and planted more than 46,000 native plants

Thanks to the schools, corporate groups and individuals who contributed to this effort. With your help, we beat our 2023 total by 17,000 plants! We also worked with more than 90 local residents on restoring their private gully land – they planted more than 5,000 plants.

We also kicked off our Nature in the City App, which has been downloaded more than 3000 times since it launched in spring. We've also recently added a new tour, through the freshly reopened Hammond Park, which is home to long-tailed bats and other special wildlife.

The new boardwalk has now been installed at Donny Park/Kukutaaruhe Gully. This boardwalk helps to protect and restore the delicate wetland in the area, which will improve biodiversity. We're now working on a cultural installation for the park, in partnership with Ngaati Wairere.
