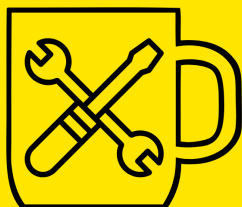

Every Bite from Go Eco

Homes in Aotearoa are throwing away over [157,000 tonnes](#) of edible food every year - that's enough to feed everyone in Dunedin for almost three years! It has taken resources like water and nutrients to grow, human labour to tend and harvest, and fossil fuels to transport it. Wasting this food is expensive too, costing the average kiwi household [\\$1,510 a year](#).

Join Every Bite and become part of our Food Appreciation Movement (FAM!). Every Bite is a month-long facilitated programme delivered by Go Eco, where you will carry out simple experiments at home to better understand and reduce your food waste.

- Learn more about the problem of food waste, why it's important and what action you can take
 - Better understand your own food waste behaviours
 - Experiment with practical food waste prevention tools, alongside your household, to see what works
 - Make small, but important changes at home that become easy, lifelong habits
- Connect with like-minded people and contribute to a growing dataset that will help us better understand and prevent Aotearoa's household food waste
