Ngā Rauemi—Resources

God's Spirit in Creation - A Pentecost worship resource

This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday.

What does that mean in the context of being an Eco Church?

We are fortunate that A Rocha Aotearoa NZ has put together some resources we can use to reflect on this either as a group or in our own time as personal reflection.

This resource endeavours to offer a collection of reflective prayers, poems, and other material to engage with Pentecost through a creation care lens. Pentecost celebrates the day that te Wairua Tapu, the Holy Spirit, came like fire on the believers. This resource invites us to explore the Spirit in light of our experience of the created world.

The resource is organised in the classic order of worship flow, starting with a call to worship and finishing with a benediction. But you can choose any of the prayers, poems, scripture, or songs that are appropriate to you and your context and integrate them into your Pentecost Sunday reflections
