#### **Eco Corner**

**Creation Connection: Resource for** 

Children is an experiential and contemplative approach where children connect to God, each other and the natural world around them by connecting to and becoming aware of God's Creation and discovering together how to act with love, care and responsible, compassionate action within it. This resource is written by Elke Keeling, in partnership with A Rocha Aotearoa New Zealand, for the Eco Church NZ project. The resource aims to give children experiences in nature where they notice the world around them, connect to it and learn to care for it. Through connection to nature, children notice the Creator at work in every detail and connect to God and

each other through their experiences. The resource follows a cycle of Ecology, Theology and Contemplative Action to help children experience, learn and make meaning that leads to thoughtful action.

There are many different resources and lots of information on this page of A Rocha's Eco Church Website. They do not need to be done in a church setting and can be utilized at home if you or your children would like to reflect more on our role in looking after creation.
