

### Eco Corner— Reducing Waste

Your food has been on a journey to get to you. It has taken resources like water and nutrients to grow, human labour to tend and harvest, and fossil fuels to transport it to you. Wasting food means all of these resources are wasted too.



Right now, it is estimated that <u>30-40%</u> of all food produced globally gets lost or wasted. Homes in Aotearoa New Zealand are throwing away over <u>157,000 tonnes</u> of edible food every year - that's enough to feed everyone in Dunedin for almost three years! Wasting this food is expensive too, costing the average kiwi household <u>\$1,510 a year</u>.

To date, 70% of Every Bite programme participants shared that they are much more aware of food waste as a problem and 86% said they feel better equipped to prevent food waste in their household.

A small group of parishioners attended a workshop on learning to reduce food waste in their home through this Every Bite program. For those that couldn't come we are going to share some ideas each week in our Eco Corner.

#### **Tip Number One**

Choose one shelf in your fridge and in your pantry to call the 'Eat Me First' shelf. By consistently putting things on this shelf which need to be eaten quickly you reduce the chance of these things being missed or lurking in the back of the fridge and ending up having to be thrown out.

What are some of the top foods that end up being thrown out? Bread, leftovers, apples, bananas, potatoes and lettuce.

Be realistic about how much you are going to eat when cooking a meal and make just enough if you find you're not eating the leftovers, or put them on the Eat Me First shelf. Bread in NZ tends to come in whole loaves so if you don't eat much maybe freeze it and defrost just what you need for each meal. When buying fresh produce think about how long it will stay fresh and how much you will eat in that time.
