Eco Corner— Reducing Waste

Ever looked in the fridge or pantry and wondered what on earth you can make with the seemingly random assortment of food there?



This may be because you haven't organised a weekly food planner where you buy just the ingredients you need for that weeks meals. There are several templates available on the internet that can help you note down the plans for your meals and what groceries you need to buy to complete them.

Sometimes however even our best laid plans go awry and we still end up wondering what to do with what we have, or our garden suddenly has an abundance of something in particular and we need some fresh ideas.

I've discovered a really useful website www.supercook.com. You can input the food that you do have at home and it will come up with different recipes for meals and side dishes you can make with those ingredients.

Let's say you're struggling to get through a whole cabbage whilst it's still nice. Have you tried pickled coleslaw, roast cabbage, stir fry cabbage etc etc—so many recipes to choose from.

Fresh food is some of the highest food that is wasted every week in NZ homes. It adds to waste and also costs us money. Why not try a new recipe?
