A walk by the Waikato River - Richard Lawrence On a walk or run by the river, I've often wondered - and especially in this week of the hīkoi - how many waka the river has carried, how many gunboats and barges. How many war cries, volleys of musket fire, cannon blasts and gun shots has it heard? How many yells, moans, shouts and sighs have carried over its surface? How many waiata, love songs and echoes of laughter has it known? How many tears have fallen into its depths? How many coronations has it borne? How much sadness dwells in the shadows? How much pain has it weighed? There are few sounds, except for the tūī. The river flows resolutely, bearing history and memory in equal part,
