

Eco Corner — Giving Climate Hope Through the CWS Christmas Appeal

Mrs Mafi is a wife, mother, and grandmother who lives on the eastern coast of Tonga. She's a retired policewoman and now carries with her a clear philosophy: "No one is left behind."

She is taking action with the women in her community to establish new vegetable gardens on higher ground. The women are also reviving resilient food plants. Together, they are discovering hopeful climate solutions as they share traditional knowledge. When they plant, they prioritise concern for older people and widows.

In Tonga, rising seas are impacting daily life. High tides damage vegetable gardens by increasing salt in the soil, while heavy rain floods low-lying homes. With rising sea levels, communities across Oceania are taking action. Confronted by the unpredictability of climate change, they are joining together. Mrs Mafi wants to build on the progress her community has made. Home composting workshops enhance soil structure. Resources like chicken coops improve their food security through diversification of income. Please support this appeal.
