Eco Corner — Hand Dryers

You may have noticed that hand dryers are appearing in our bathrooms.

We are fortunate to have solar panels on our roof which contribute towards our daily power use and also feed back into the grid.

When we completed our waste audit 2 years ago we discovered that 90% of our rubbish was paper towels from drying hands, which unfortunately can not be recycled and has meant that, with the increase in people using our buildings that we were making more rubbish than we could dispose of.

Hence the hand dryers.

To make the best use of these dryers you should gently move your hands through the air about 5mm from the surface backwards and forwards turning them over so the whole of your hand goes through the air.

Please remain at home if you have cold, covid or flu-like symptoms. Many in our community are vulnerable to respiratory infections and will appreciate it if you do not come to the church premises until you are well. Thank you
