Fast from problems that overwhelm; Feast on prayer that sustains.

Reduce

Reducing the amount of waste you produce is the best way to help the environment.



Reuse

Instead of throwing things away, try to find ways to use them again



Recycle

Recycling things that have already been used, to make new things for better purposes.



We are reducing the amount of power we are taking from the national grid by having solar panels installed, switching appliances off at the wall when they are not being used, switching lights off as we leave rooms, having air conditioning on timers and changing to more power efficient light bulbs.

We have significantly reduced the amount of paper we use by sending out newsletters and other information electronically and putting the worship services on the screen instead of printing lots of paper copies.

We are currently working on a plan to bring the bike racks around to the front of the building where there is better security to encourage those that are capable to bike to our premises instead of using fuel in a car.

We have now finished installing hand driers in all 4 bathrooms. An audit we did with Pare Kore showed that most of our landfill waste was paper towels. By using the power we have created to run hand driers we have significantly reduced our weekly landfill waste.

Please remain at home if you have cold, covid or flu-like symptoms. Many in our community are vulnerable to respiratory infections and will appreciate it if you do not come to the church premises until you are well. Thank you
