Eco Corner— reduce, reuse, recycle. What are we doing here at Chartwell Cooperating Church?



Reduce

Reducing the amount of waste you produce is the best way to help the environment.



Reuse

Instead of throwing things away, try to find ways to use them again



Recycle

Recycling things that have already been used, to make new things for better purposes.

Reuse

Once we have finished with an item, what do we do with it?

Can we reuse it for the same purpose over and over again or can we use it for another purpose?

If we have no use for it, but it is still capable of doing the job it's intended for, can someone else make use of it?

If it is broken or needs sharpening or not working, can it be repaired, tested or sharpened to make it usable again?

If you don't need it, someone else might be happy to use it once it's repaired. Sometimes we upgrade something around our house. What do we do with the old one?

At Chartwell Cooperating Church we have two opportunities to help reuse household items.

- Our repair café gives you the opportunity to get items repaired, sharpened and/or tested for safety before you use it again
- 2. At our Autumn & Spring Fairs you can donate anything you don't need and purchase things you do need, with out having to buy them new.

Please remain at home if you have cold, covid or flu-like symptoms. Many in our community are vulnerable to respiratory infections and will appreciate it if you do not come to the church premises until you are well. Thank you
