Eco Corner— reduce, reuse, recycle. What are we doing here at Chartwell Cooperating Church?



Reduce

Reducing the amount of waste you produce is the best way to help the environment.



Reuse

Instead of throwing things away, try to find ways to use them



Recycle

Recycling things that have already been used, to make new things for better purposes.

Recycle

Do you know all the things you can recycle here at Church?

Whilst here at church, we encourage you to recycle everything you can, and we also recycle what we can to reduce the amount of waste going to landfill.

This is a very timely topic as March 30th is the International Day of Zero Waste as decided by the UN General Assembly as part of their Sustainable Development program.

1. There are bins in each of the church kitchens for items that HCC recycle:

Paper, cardboard, tins, plastics 1, 2 and 5, glass and food waste

- 2. There are also bins for soft plastic recycling. (plastic packaging and bags that can be scrunched up in to balls)
- 3. We recycle the church's light bulbs, batteries, printer consumables and glass bottle lids.

We also now use more energy efficient light bulbs and rechargeable batteries to reduce what needs to be recycled and where possible buy in bulk to reduce packaging waste.
