Break down of last month's waste

8% glass, 14% food scraps, 22% mixed recycling, 56% landfill

Altogether 236000 kgs of glass were recycled, 387000 kgs of food waste and 616000 kgs of mixed recycling. Using these recycling options is the easiest thing we can do every day to make a difference to our environment.
