## Eco Corner—

Tips for keeping warm this winter without using too much electricity.

Pull curtains when it's cold.

Curtains and blinds should fit snugly against the window frame and should be longer than sill length.

Use timers and thermostats on heaters and heat pumps.

Use a candle to detect drafts around windows, doors and vents and then use draft stoppers or window sealant to stop the draft.

Invest in double glazing.

Make sure you turn off your electric blanket before you go to sleep.

Warm the parts of the house you are using. You can shut doors to other areas.

Use potlids or the range hood when cooking. This prevents a lot of damp air in your home.
