### Community Corner - Repair Café

The next repair cafe is on Saturday, 7 June from 2:00 to 4:00 PM. Bring in your garden tools for sharpening (we have already done many before) or your broken kitchen equipment, or any other equipment if you

think that it can be repaired. Al McGregor can test your electric blankets now that winter is at the doorstep. You must have felt the cold recently, particularly early



in the morning. Testing electric blankets is very important because of the proximity of your body to the power inside the blanket. Generally, you should turn off the blanket when you go to bed. don't sleep on it when it is powered up.

Recently, we have cleaned up some old parts in general and polished or painted them so that they can be proudly displayed again in the kitchen or a bookcase, wherever everyone can see them. We are not as good as the artisans on the TV program "Repair Shop" but one never knows what we can come up with. I repaired a barometer that had a broken glass window and the owner thought that it was not working anymore, but after I cleaned the mechanics inside, it is proudly showing the correct air pressure again.

There are many other examples, but if you don't give us the chance to help you, it will never happen. Jack Brinkman

Repairing bikes, tools, equipment, textiles, toys, wooden items etc saves these products from going to landfill which nicely fits into our church's Eco Church philosophy. If you don't need the item anymore and it can be fixed, we can always sell it at the next church fair. If you have skills in repair, do come along and join the team.
