Earth Diverse Annual Matariki Multicultural Tree Planting

Saturday June 14th 10am—3pm, Waiwhakareke Natural Heritage Park Parking on Baverstock Road.

This is a community wide tree planting event supported by WIC, WMC, HCC and many more community groups. Bring a spade or shovel, gumboots, appropriate outdoor gear, gardening gloves, and water.

If you don't want to dig, there are other ways of helping out (like bringing a small food donation, or helping out with setting out and serving a light lunch). Any ready to eat food donations like bread, cheese, lettuce, tomato, baked goods, milk, tea, coffee, juice etc will be much appreciated.

Please bring your own plates, cutlery and mugs to reduce waste.

The aim is to plant over 4500 saplings,.
