#### **Community Corner - Healing Group**

#### What do we do?

We meet once a month to pray and make a list of people in our parish and beyond who have requested prayer for themselves or others have requested for them. The list is entirely confidential. This is then circulated to all members of the Prayer Group for ongoing prayer.

Each Sunday before the 9.30am service, some members of the Prayer Group meet in the Quiet Room to pray for the service leaders, the needs of the people attending and those who are unable to attend. We also pray that the Scripture and Reflection will touch the hearts of those attending the service.

At the 9.30am service two members volunteer to be available during communion, during the last hymn and after the service in the side chapel for brief prayer. A prayer card may be given. You can also request prayers for the Healing Group to add to their list. When there is a Healing Service, these volunteers work together to provide prayer and anointing oil.

We also provide a prayer steward to meet the ministry team in the vestry before the service and offer to pray for all who are taking part in the service.

#### Who are we?

We are members of this church who have followed God's call to provide prayer ministry individually, and as a group for this church. If you feel this is a ministry for you, you would be very welcome. Please contact the office
