Eco Corner—the hidden environmental cost of cloud storage Part One

Cloud storage has become an everyday part of life for many of us. From backing up family photos, to running entire businesses, it creates a sense of ease and security. But this simple act - saving a file to the cloud - triggers a complex chain of events in distant data centres.

The 'cloud' is really a network of powerful computers stored in huge warehouses. Every message, every back-up, every binge-watched show relies on physical machines running non-stop. The word 'cloud' hides the reality of an energy-hungry resource-intensive industry working behind the scenes. Some data centres are so huge that they use as much power as a small city.

Electricity is only part of it too - many rely on power produced from coal, oil or natural gas. The digital sector including cloud storage is responsible for around 4 % of worldwide CO2 emissions. That number might seem small, but it is similar to those from the entire airline industry.
