May the children find joy, laughter, and friendship.


Strengthen our youth leaders with patience, creativity, and energy.


Do you live on a road that has traffic driving passed? Could we put up a Fair sign on your front fence or put one in the garden on a stake?


Do you walk around your local community or have kids that might go for a walk during the school holidays? We need leaflets advertising the Fair and Book Sale delivered.
