Community Corner Pataka Kai Update

Over the past few years, we have been deeply grateful for the generosity of our community in supporting the Pataka Kai (Community Pantry). Many have given food with open hearts, and many in the community have been helped through this shared kindness. Thank you.

Unfortunately, we have recently seen increasing misuse of the pantry, along with rubbish and damage around the Pataka Kai cupboards. It has also become a dumping point, which is unfair for our local residents, our church, and for those who genuinely rely on the service. Currently, we are unable to maintain the Pataka Kai service to the level it needs and deserves.

As a result, we will be **removing the Pataka Kai shelves for now** and cleaning up the surrounding area.

We remain committed to supporting our community and will revisit the concept in 2026 to explore whether a more sustainable and manageable alternative exists.
