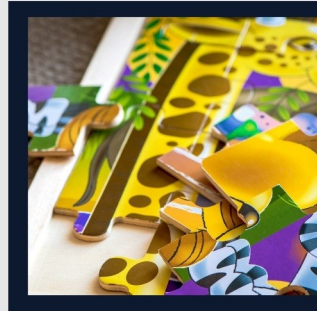

As part of our commitment to loving creation and being an Eco Church we are committed to reducing our carbon footprint. As part of this commitment we installed 20 solar panels back in 2023 which have served us well. This was always planned as Phase One of installing solar panels and was fully funded by grants and specified donations. Since that time we have more than quadrupled the number of people using our Facility and installed hand dryers in the bathrooms to drastically reduce our rubbish - hence we are using a lot more power! We have been quoted for Phase Two which is 18 solar panels and will proceed with this when we have received enough funding.
